- Review and approval of minutes from the August 20th planning meeting.

- Pastor's report from Fr Tom:
 - Presbytery office will be moved effective July, 2017. Corby Hall is being renovated and 14 priests have to relocate. Some will need to move into the Presbytery causing the need to move the parish offices. Many issues need to be addressed such as duration of living quarters, storage options, and socialization after Mass. Mail, library money counters space are also considerations. Fr Tom is looking to coordinate with the priests of Holy Cross for options.
